





Scientists: nearby Mungo National Park is a part of the Willandra Lakes World Heritage Area, It was at Mungo, in the drought-affected summer of 1969, that a young scientist stumbled across the remains of a cremated skeleton of a human, Carbon dating showed that Mungo woman was at least 26,000 years old, and that Mungo Man lived some 62,000 years ago. The discovery threatened to rewrite the history of human occupation in Australia, and had profound implications for the origins of modern man. Stone flake tools are scattered across the landscape, and peeking out of the mud are ancient wombat holes, fossilised chunks of Eucalyptus trees, and the bones of long-dead marsupials, including extinct buffalo-sized wombats and giant kangaroos. A tour quide is essential.

Agriculturists: Mildura is considered the centre of Australia's food bowl. Its irrigated agricultural land produces most of Australia's dried fruit, as well as table grapes and citrus. The area also grows almonds, pistachios, olives, carrots, asparagus, and is the hub for wine and table grape production.

Oenologists/Winemakers: Mildura's Mediterranean climates favor viticulture and the regions rich history of grape growing and wine production. The region is how to some 27 wineries, from boutique establishments to multinational companies.

Resource Managers: Excellent educational networks and is home to respected early learning, primary, secondary and tertiary educational providers. Innovative technique in water, salinity, waste and sustainable energy management have also emerged in the region.






